



COURSE STRUCTURE

The CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) is comprised of 16 units of competency. 13 of these units are classified as Core units and 3 are classified as Electives. You must complete all 16 units of competency to receive the qualification. The units of competency offered by Core Industry Training are in line with the licensing requirements in most states.
